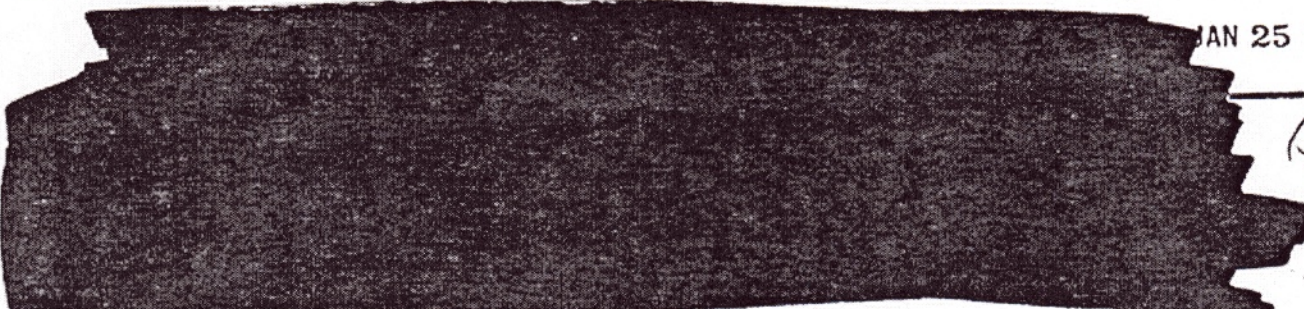
ON JANUARY EIGHTEEN, NINETEEN SEVENTYTWO, CAMIL AND LOW  
 CONSTANTINI, STUDENT AT UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA(UF), GAINESVILLE  
 AND MEMBER OF YOUNG AMERICANS FOR FREEDOM (YAF) AND FORMER  
 LIEUTENANT IN UNITED STATES ARMY AND AN ADVISOR TO SOUTH VIETNAMESE  
 FORCES APPEARED ON OPEN FORUM RADIO PROGRAM KNOWN AS "DIALOGUE"  
 OVER RADIO STATION WRUF, STATE OWNED RADIO STATION LOCATED ON UF  
 CAMPUS. CAMIL TOOK POSITION THAT UNITED STATES ILLEGALLY INVOLVED  
 IN SOUTH VIETNAM AND HAS CAUSED DAMAGE TO SOUTH VIETNAMESE  
 RATHER THAN HELP THEM. CONSTANTINI EMPHASIZED UNITED STATES  
 JUSTIFIED IN INVOLVEMENT AND HAS ACTUALLY WON WAR AGAINST NORTH  
 VIETNAMESE.
